Business**

Emil investigated what the AMA would pay for site improvements. This is in regards to putting a concrete walkway from the clubhouse to the pilot station to provide a handicap accessible pilot station. AMA will pay 10% only. Doug got prices for the materials themselves for a walkway that is 50 X 4, 4 inches deep. It will be about \$580. In addition we would need access to concrete tools, like floats and edgers. Also, would need equipment to dig it out. Dan has access to equipment to dig, Dave has an edger, and perhaps a float could be rented if no one knows someone who has one. First, though, we need to get approval from the Trumbull County Fair Board as we just lease from them. Doug will contact the Fair Board for permission. Also, Tino offered to donate \$300 to help pay for this project. Thanks, Tino. Doug suggested that we enlist one of our club members knowledgeable about this type of work to supervise to ensure it's done properly. Emil may be able to get some forms.

August Fun Fly – Dan will cook, Doug will arrange to get people to work at the gate, Emil, Doug, and Steven will continue to work on getting donations of prizes and coupons. Suggestion made to have a U-Can-Do plane as the grand prize. Darrel made a motion to buy the plane, it was seconded, and motion carried. Dave will approach Kevin from Austintown Hobby to see if he will go half on the plane, as there was discussion of this previously. Once Dave gets plane specs, Dave will send info to Dan to get tickets printed. Group agreed that there will be no cash option this time.

Business**

Doug got a price to have garbage pick-up at the field from Bristol Garbage. The cost is \$ 17 per month, which is 2 55-gallon bags weekly. Members expressed concern about allowing garbage at the field. It tends to attract bees, raccoons, skunk, etc. Also, people start putting their household garbage in it, and lastly, it's hard to get anyone to take the garbage home when cans get full. General consensus is that we keep it as is. Everyone is responsible for removing their own garbage from the field. We will put the cans out during events only. Tino offered to take garbage home when necessary to the dumpster at his business.

Emil made motion to permanently move the date for the Electric Fly-In to the first weekend in June. Jack seconded; motion carried. Discussion on whether to have on Saturday or Sunday. Some prefer Saturday because of church and family activities. We have until end of this year to decide. Will bring up at future meeting.

Thanks to Joe Ramps and Doug for donating some plastic chairs.

Dan asked if anyone is interested in Club T-Shirts. There was some interest, so Dan will get prices. This will be a pre-order only; we will take orders and will only order shirts for those who wish to purchase, not just buying a lot of shirts.

Discussion about gravel for the parking lot. All agreed it needed to be grated/raked out right now; that should do it. Keep in mind that we'll probably need to buy some gravel in the next year or so, so will need to ensure there is enough money in treasury.

Darrel is going to check with the state about mowing the east end of the field around the horse trail.

Discussion about adding more electric outlets in the clubhouse to accommodate all the chargers for people flying electric now. There is 200 amp service, so there is room to grow. Dave suggested that we construct shelves attached to the inside of the folding window so that it's inside when the windows are shut and will fold out when the windows are open. Dave will check on cost of electric strip to install for now.

Doug announced there will be a club picnic with steaks, sweet corn, etc. again this year. It will be 2 weeks after the August Fun Fly. More information to come, but wanted to get this on the calendar.

We have one person, Jim, who attended this meeting and is interested in joining the club. He has a DGI Quad. He has a membership application and will submit if he decides to join. Reminder that he must first get an AMA membership.
