Business**

Discussed the specifics for the August 3rd Fun Fly. Tickets are printed and were handed out to members at the meeting; rest will be mailed. Doug and Dan will share the duties of Contest Director for the event. Doug will handle getting members to work the gate for 30-minute shifts. Dan will be cooking; Nick will provide a pot of sauce. Emil has gathered quite a few items for the Chinese raffle. Dave has the planes at his house for the grand prizes. We should be all set.

Club T-Shirts – Dan brought up asking if we wanted to order T-Shirts. We will wait until Fall for this because Dan’s daughter works at TCTC and will have her students do the setup of the artwork, which will be free.

Handicapped Ramp – Doug advised that King Brothers will not be able to schedule this until at least fall due to their workload.
