Unfinished Business Election of 2017 officers: no new nominations. Current officers were voted in unanimously for the 2017 season.

There was discussion at September meeting about possibly combining winter meeting and indoor flying. Officers have decided it would be best to keep them separate and the members present agreed. So there will be a November meeting to be held at the Cortland Post Office. The March meeting will be held at the Cortland Library. At the November meeting, the membership will decide if we should have meetings in January and February. THERE WILL BE NO DECEMBER MEETING. Also at the November meeting, we'll continue the By-Laws revisions and the Safety Addendum.

Continued discussion on renaming the field from Ernie Hall Memorial Field to Flying Aeros RC Field. Motion made by Tom to change the name; seconded by Cliff; motion passed unanimously.

Discussion on repainting the sign at the entrance to our field. Members will get together and work on a plan to repainting.

New Business Electric at the clubhouse will be kept on until at least after January 1st Freeze Fly.

We need to decide on dates for the 2017 events so that we may plan ahead and Dan may post in the AMA magazine. We have tentatively set the dates as Saturday, June 3rd for the electric fly-in, and Saturday, August 5th as the Annual Fun Fly. Doug will check with other clubs to ensure there is no conflict, and if not, we'll set these dates.
