Unfinished Business We have one bid for grass cutting from Rick Seidle for \$1500. Motion made by Cliff H. to accept bid, seconded by Mario; motion carried unanimously. We still need to have the field rolled. Dan has a roller and Cliff has offered to take ATV out to field and pull it, so Dan and Cliff will coordinate the rolling of the field, weather permitting. Dan will arrange to have the porta-john serviced prior to May electric flying event.

New Business John S. brought up subject of trying to get younger members to join and made suggestion to post in the school newspapers about our club. Anyone with connections to high schools, please reach out and give them information for the newspaper. Lori will write up article for Cortland News as they will post the article for free; we will try to get new members.

There are quite a few rather large holes at the field; we need to get these fixed. Suggestions led to the fact that the drain tile has failed below so we really don't need to worry about that. So, we are going to fill holes first with concrete mix, then cover with dirt. The concrete will absorb moisture and harden on its own. Keith A. made a motion to have a Spring Clean-up prior to April meeting at the field on April 11th at 4 p.m.; Cliff H. seconded the motion and motion passed unanimously. Dan M. will buy the concrete mix and bring to meeting, as well as arrange to have a load of dirt delivered by that date. We estimate it will be 5 – 7 yards and will be dumped at the end of the gravel parking lot near the orange cone where it is very low and constantly has standing water. There is plenty of money in the raffle fund, so there will be pizza provided as well. Please, anyone who can come, bring a shovel, wheelbarrow, or just some elbow grease to help us fill these holes as well as general cleanup at the field. Meeting will follow at 7 p.m.

May Fun Fly – decision was made to have an E-Flite Mini Pulse XL as the grand prize, along with pilot prizes. Dan will get tickets printed. Dan is also going to send in ad for August Fun Fly to ensure that it gets into the magazine for at least 3 months prior to event. Next month, we will finalize details for September event.
