We will have a January 1<sup>st</sup> Freeze Fly again this year. Scheduled start time will be noon, weather permitting, of course.

For 2014, our club selected the dates for the annual events. The Electric Fly-in will be held Sunday, May 18<sup>th</sup> and the Annual Fun Fly will be held Sunday, August 3<sup>rd</sup>.
